

WD-Assign17 – CSS Roll Over Menus

For this assignment you will create a table layout set up with 3 link styles.

- 1) The first link style should be the default for the page and should automatically applied to *links in the body text*. These links should be set to launch in the same window.
- 2) The second link style should be created with a class and applied to a *horizontal menu* just below the heading. These links should be set to launch in the same window.
- 3) The third link style should be created with a class and apply to a *vertical menu*. These links should be set to launch in a separate window.

The rest of the page should be decorated with a color scheme that is based on 3-6 complementary colours (use the color scheme picker).

Menu Criteria

- The two roll-over menus should use different colours that work well together on the same page.
- Your colors should complement each other well, and should not be too bright or offensive.
- Your div containers should use borders, background, width, alignment, and padding as necessary.
- Your a:states should be defined with borders, backgrounds, widths, and other effects as necessary.
- *links do not have to open an actual link. Just put href="#" for testing purposes.*
