

WD-Assign19 – Social Cause Website

Websites are very powerful tools in many social agendas for many groups that are trying to influence politicians and the public. Your assignment is to find a world issue that is important to you and to construct a website that informs the public about it. These could be issues such as pollution, nuclear testing, lack of funding for third world countries, or something else that is important to many people from around the world. You must clear this topic with me before beginning. This is your chance to make something that is important to you, that could actually make a difference.

Your assignment must include the following features:

- It must be a website of at least 6 pages stored in a folder called "***firstnamelastname-WDAssign19***".
- All pages must have the same structure. This layout must be created using a table.
- All pages must be linked to every other page (these links launching internally) and each page must include a link to another site (that launches externally)
- You must use an external CSS document to decorate your website. I will expect to see you using CSS rules and classes.
- You must include either a horizontal or vertical navigation bar that connects all of your main website pages. These links must be set to behave as rollover links, and should suit the color scheme and design of the rest of the page.
- You must also have a separate link style for body links.
- Your color scheme for the page should be reflective of the issue that you are raising awareness for.
- Remember that including layered div tags with various borders and background colors on your pages creates unique and interesting designs.
- Also keep in mind that the images that you include are very powerful in furthering your cause. It is important that you choose them carefully, and make your text wraps neatly around them.
- Be aware of the use of padding in elements so that things do not look cluttered.
- Be sure to use an example of a tiled image background as the background of the entire page or in a single element.
- All pages should be properly written (indented code that is properly spaced and easy to read) and all pages must validate.

When finished, place a copy of the entire folder "***firstnamelastname-WDAssign19***" in my dropoff folder.

Site uses a table structure that is consistent from page to page	/5
